Each school is limited to 15 of their best dog park landscape designs which will be judged and ONLY 1 selected for construction.

Landscape Beginning Installation:

Saturday, March 20, 2010, from 10 am to 10 pm, in the World of Agriculture Construction MUST be started by **Sunday, March 21, 2010**. Students may begin installation **Saturday, March 20, 10 am to 10 pm, Sunday, March 21, 10 am to 9 pm, Monday, March 22 and Tuesday, March 23 from 4 pm to 9 pm** All installations must be completed by **9 pm Tuesday, March 23**. Decorative items* may be added and touch-up* completed on **Thursday, March 25, between 1 pm and 6 p m ONLY**.

NOTE: Decorative items include non-plant elements such as tables, chairs, benches, statuary, artwork and potted plants. This is not to include items such as gazebos, fences, trellis or other items which are normally a permanent fixture in a landscape. Touch-up includes cleaning, addition of a small amount of mulch, and limited replacement/addition of plants.

Design must include the following:

Shade trees, good drainage, maintainable turf, benches, tables, walking/running path, separate areas for large and small dogs, safety fences and/or barriers, double gated entrance/exit, water fountains for humans and dogs, buffer zones from neighbors concerned about barking, covered trash receptacles, disposal product dispensers, bulletin boards for posting notices, clear and concise aesthetically pleasing signage, agility equipment and swimming ponds.

Landscape Completion Date:

Tuesday, March 23, 2010, to be completed by 9:00 pm

Rules:

1. **A landscape sketch must be attached to your entry form. Any sketch that does not have an entry form will be disqualified.**
2. On the back of your sketch list names of all team members (alternates will NOT be allowed), names of plants and explanation of any special design feature.
3. Give the judges as much information as you think would be helpful to them, and remember to be neat.
4. This sketch will be the deciding factor as to who may enter the Landscape Construction Competition.
5. All entries must be submitted by an Agricultural Education teacher or 4-H leader.
6. Landscape MUST be equivalent to original drawing and may be hand-drawn or a computer assisted drawing (CAD).
7. Size will be assigned as follows:
16' X 20'
8. All physical installation of plant material and decoration must be done by students.
9. Landscape teams will consist of no more than 4 students.
10. Sand, mulch and railroad ties will be provided by The Fair.
11. Completed landscape will be judged on Thursday, March 25, 2010, at 7:00 pm in the World of Agriculture. One representative must be present.
12. The above guidelines will be strictly enforced.

Decorative items* may be added and touch-up* completed on **Thursday, March 25, between 1 pm and 6 p m ONLY**.

7. Size will be assigned as follows:
Middle school: 10 feet x 8 feet
Sr. high: 15 feet x 8 feet
8. All physical installation of plant material and decoration must be done by students.
9. Landscape teams will consist of no more than 4 students.
10. Sand, mulch and railroad ties will be provided by The Fair.
11. Completed landscape will be judged on Thursday, March 25, 2010, at 7:00 pm in the World of Agriculture. One representative from each exhibit must be present.
12. The above guidelines will be strictly enforced.
