Livestock Judging:

1. Exhibitors will **NOT** automatically be entered into this category.
2. **In order to compete in this event, exhibitors are required to list this category on their entry form.**
3. Participation is limited to bona-fide 4-H and FFA members from Miami-Dade County.
4. Only market animal exhibitors are eligible to participate in this contest.
5. No teams will be allowed to participate.
6. Participant will be required to judge multiple livestock classes, (one heifer class, one bull class, one cow class, one cow/calf pair class, one market steer class, one market hog class, and one market lamb class).
7. Participants will estimate USDA grade parameters for one slaughter steer class, slaughter hogs, and slaughter lamb.
8. Questions will be asked on various classes throughout the contest based on performance records and visual appraisals.
9. Exhibitors are allowed to take their own notes during the contest.
10. Absolutely no talking will be tolerated during the contest, any contestant violating this rule will have their cards taken and will be disqualified from the contest.

Class 1 - Jr. Livestock Judging (ages 8 - 10 as of 8/24/09)

Class 2 - Int. Livestock Judging (ages 11 - 14 as of 8/24/09)

Class 3 - Sr. Livestock Judging (ages 15 - 18 as of 8/24/09)
