Includes:

Original ceramic items that have been handbuilt, wheel thrown or poured into a mold. All items must be finished and fired, including ceramic jewelry.

Rules:

1. Entries limited to 2 per student. For 2 part entries (e.g. salt and pepper shakers), etc., note "2 pieces" on exhibit entry tag.
2. No group entries allowed in this division.
3. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE FIRED IN A KILN.** No plaster of paris or air dried items will be accepted.
4. Exhibitor's name or initials, month and year must be etched into the bottom piece prior to first firing (greenware). **Entries must have been made since the 2009 Miami Dade County Fair & Exposition.**
5. Description of item must be on the entry form.
6. No chipped or broken pieces accepted.
7. Exhibit entry tags must be attached with a string or rubber band.
8. Bottoms of all mold items must be finished (glazed or painted). Hand built items must be smooth on bottoms.
9. Entry must be the work of the student only.
10. All tiles must be student made and if they are mounted must have the name and date on the front.
11. **NEW: Outside dimensions should be a minimum of 4" x 4"**
12. Outside dimensions of all mounted pieces should not exceed 14" x 14".
13. Classroom teachers and club leaders may enter no more than five renditions of the same exhibit.
14. Any entrant not conforming to the above rules will be **DISQUALIFIED** at check-in.

Judging Criteria:

Quality, neatness, workmanship, originality, effective use of material(s) and total overall effectiveness.

Classes:

- Class 1 - Hand Built Entry
- Class 2 - Piece from Mold Entry
- Class 3 - Wheel Thrown Entry
