1. **ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO TWENTY OF A KIND. ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO 50 TOTAL PER SCHOOL. NO GROUP ENTRIES.**
2. Students may submit 2 entries in this division. Each entry must be a different type. (e.g. one leather craft and one yarn craft = 2 entries)
3. Kits will ONLY be accepted for leather crafts and exceptional education entries.
4. Entry tags must be secured on the front lower right hand corner.
5. Entries can be no larger than 12" X 18" including framing.
6. Hanging projects must have proper hardware securely attached.
7. All entries should be neat, clean, and dry. Staples, tape, and glue should not be visible. No damaged projects will be accepted.
8. **NO FOOD PRODUCTS** (e.g. macaroni, rice, etc.), **NO STICKS** (e.g. popsicle, toothpick, clothespin, etc.), **NO GLITTER OF ANY KIND, NO GLUE GUNS.**
9. Any entry other than the ones listed below must have permission of a Superintendent from this division.
10. **Due to space limitations only entries winning FIRST and SECOND Places will displayed.**

4. **Maximum entries per school is 50.**
5. **NOT ACCEPTABLE: Non-handmade (purchased items glued together), food (beans, macaroni, rice, etc.) sticks (popsicle, clothes pins, tooth-picks), glitter of any kind, glue guns, seasonal themes (X-mas, Valentine, Halloween, etc.), aluminum paper plates, bottles, paper plates (plastic or glass), plastic items, science projects or social studies projects.**
6. This division will accept only those exhibits expressly made for the 2010 fair.
7. Size limitation including framing – Not to exceed **18" x 18" x 18"**.
8. **Due to space limitations only 1st & 2nd places will be put on display.**
9. The Crafts division cannot be held responsible for damaged or lost items.
10. Items entered in the wrong division will not be judged or shown.
11. All Exceptional Education Student exhibits, regardless of the entering procedures will be judged solely by Exceptional Educational Student judges familiar with the criteria needed to properly evaluate the level of achievement.
