#### Rules:

1. All entries will be divided into frame categories. (Not traditional picture or art type)
2. They will be judged on creativity, attractiveness, originality, and neatness.
3. All "Animals" will be on display at the fairgrounds during the upcoming Miami-Dade County Fair and Exposition®.
4. **Class 1** - Size must be 3 feet long by 3 feet high. This would be a large farm animal such as a cow or horse.
5. **Class 2** - Size must be 2 feet long by 2 feet high. This would be a medium sized farm animal such as sheep, goats, and pigs.
6. **Class 3** - Size must be 18 inches long by 12 inches high. This would include small farm animals such as a chicken or rabbit.
7. Materials accepted but not limited to paper mache, cotton, batting, faux fur, string and feathers.

Class 2 - Small Frame Body  
Class 3 - No Frame Body

#### Judging Criteria:

Creativity, attractiveness, originality, and neatness.

#### Rules:

1. Entry tags must be attached securely on front, lower, right-hand corner.
2. **Size Limitation: Including framing – Not to exceed 8" x 10".**
3. This division will accept only those exhibits expressly made for the 2010 fair.
4. In addition to art materials (crayons, paint, yarn, twine, markers, etc.) art work should be created through the use of cut/torn paper. **NOT ACCEPTABLE:** Non-handmade (purchased items glued together), food (beans, etc.), sticks (popsicle, clothes pins and toothpicks), stickers, pre-cut patterns, cotton, fur & feathers.
5. **Entries limited to 1 project per student. Enter only 200 projects per school. Individual entries only – NO GROUP ENTRIES.**
6. **First & Second Places will be put on display due to space limitations.**
7. All entries should be neat and clean. Staples, tape and glue should not be visible. No damage, however slight, will be accepted. Crafts cannot be responsible for lost/damaged items. See official rules on page 14.
8. Items entered in the wrong division will not be judged or shown.
9. The Fair™ management has jurisdiction over interpretation of these rules.
10. ANY ENTRY NOT CONFORMING TO THE ABOVE RULES OR THE OFFICIAL FAIR RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. All descisions of the judges are final.
11. Examples include: Paper mosaics, landscapes, cityscapes, portraits, radial and folk art designs.
