General Rules:

1. Exhibitor may submit no more than one entry in each class below.
2. The competitions listed below will take place during The Fair™ opening hours and the foods will be judged while the exhibitor is present.
3. Participant must bring in all supplies, ingredients and utensils needed for his/her entry.
4. Food must be on a disposable plate (paper, plastic) or hard form.
5. All items must be made entirely by the exhibitor.

Class 1 Rules:

1. **This class is only open to students in or above the 6th grade.**
2. Participant must bring in cake (any size or shape) on disposable plate or hard form.
3. Participant must bring in all supplies, ingredients and utensils for decorating.
4. Participant will be given thirty minutes to decorate cake.
5. Cakes will be judged solely on outside appearance.
6. Cakes may be taken by the participant after judging or The Fair™ will dispose of them.

Class 2 Rules

1. **This class is only open to students in K through the 5th grade.**
2. Participant must bring in six undecorated cupcakes on a disposable plate or hard form.
3. Participant must bring in all supplies, ingredients and utensils needed for decorating.
4. Participant will be given thirty minutes to decorate cupcakes.
5. Cupcakes will be judged solely on outside appearance.
6. Cupcakes may be taken by the participant after judging or The Fair™ will dispose of them.
