Follow these steps carefully: Use the **Club Entry Form**, the division code is 53, include class number. In the space provided for Club Leaders information fill in all applicable information for the leader. The space provided for Club Information under club name, write: TROOP and the troop number (e.g. Troop 111). All projects entered must be of exhibit quality and show planning, time, and effort. Projects should reflect the age level of the girl.

3 Project Limit:

To allow for the appropriate time to plan, design and create an original entry, no more than three projects per girl may be submitted. All Entry/Claim tags must be visible on the front of each project and securely attached. **Do not detach claim ticket.** You must give your troop number at time of check-in.

Rules:

1. All girls entering a project in The Fair™ must be between the ages of 5 and 17 years old and must be a registered member of the Girl Scout Movement for the 2009-2010 school year.
2. Entry size limits: 20" x 20" x 20". Weight shall be no more than five pounds. All entries must be stable and durable. **These limits will be strictly enforced.**
3. There is no size exception for sewing projects as long as it can be folded for display, down to 20" x 20", because of space limitations.
4. All entries must be made by the individual Girl Scout and should be original work and not be parent/adult generated.
5. Exhibits designed to be hung **MUST** have proper hardware securely attached, easily manageable, without parts falling off and **BE READY FOR HANGING.**
6. No food, unbaked clay, plants, science project boards or Popsicle stick projects.
7. **Due to space limitations only entries winning FIRST and Second Places may be put on display.** Decision of the judges is final.
9. You must have your claim tickets and Troop number at check-out, in order to claim your exhibit and premiums.
