Rules:

1. Students may submit no more than one entry in each type listed below. Exceptions must be cleared with Superintendent.
2. No more than fifty renditions of the exhibit will be accepted per school.
3. All entries must be stitched by hand. **Machine – stitched items will be disqualified.**
4. Only completed works will be accepted. Pictures must be framed, pillows stuffed, linen hemmed or fringed, etc.
5. Hooking must be securely bound on all edges with no canvas showing.
6. Wall hangings limited to 3ft. X 3ft; anything larger should be approved by the Superintendent.
8. **Entry tags must be securely fastened to the entry.**
