6. Points will be deducted if sheet music is used.
7. Applications not completed in their entirety will not be processed.
8. The decision of the judges is final.
9. All students entering this class must have proof of a **minimum of 2 years piano study** with a professionally qualified piano teacher.
10. The teacher's and parent's signature is required on the entry form.
11. **No substitutions after March 1, 2010.**

Rules:

1. Due to the limited amount of performance times available each Fair, entries in all classes will be limited and therefore accepted for scheduling on a "first come, first served" basis.
2. A student may enter one solo class (solo) or he/she may enter a combination (e.g., one solo plus one duet/trio or one ensemble).
3. **Teachers entering students in the solo classes (class one) are limited to 7 students.**
4. Performers entering more than one class must submit separate entry forms for each class. This form can be found online at www.thefairiexhibits.com
5. Presentations in all classes will be limited to one presentation of no more than 5 minutes.
6. Points will be deducted if sheet music is used in solo classes.
7. Compact Discs or Cassette tapes may be used for vocal accompaniment only if the musical score is recorded (no backup voices).
8. All cassette tapes must be cued-up to the beginning of the tape.
9. Applications not completed in their entirety will not be processed.
10. The decision of the judges is final.
11. Class 1 - *Woodwind, brass, percussion, string - If guitar, no vocal is allowed.* All students entering this class must have proof of a **minimum of 18 months instrumental study** with a professionally qualified teacher. The teacher's and parent's signature is required on the entry form.
12. Class 2 and 3 - PIANO DUETS and TRIOS are NOT accepted.
13. **No substitutions after March 1, 2010.**
